



DIY Wedding Ceremony Wine Box

Materials

Item	Qty	
Wood, Plywood, or MDF 1x6	1	
Wood, Plywood, or MDF 1x4	1	
Numbers (depending on if you add a date)		
Letters (depending on if you add a name or initials)		
Spray Paint (Optional)		

^{*} Board Dimensions are "nominal". Actual dimensions are smaller due to lumber industry standards. Cuts are actual length.



A select/premium board or plywood comes with a smoother surface finish. It is clear or has very few tight knots, and it will have straight and sharp edges. This grade of wood pairs well with other boards or panels better and requires less time to sand and finish.

Tools Used





Miter Saw

Tape Measure

Also Needed: **Brad Nailer**



Battery Tip: A 4.0 Ah battery is recommended to be paired with high amp draw tools for maximum efficiency.

Lumber Cut List

Board*	Description	Cut to	Qty
1x4	Sides	15"	2
1x6	Top & Bottom	15"	2
1x4	Ends	4" x 3" (approx)	2

Assembly Instructions

Step 1

Cut your 15" base and top from the 1x6.

Step 2

Cut your 15" sides from the 1x4.



Step 3

Cut your ends from the 1x4.

Step 4

Assemble your box.

Place a bottom cut board on a flat surface. Add each side and then add the top.

Attach the top to each side with a brad nailer.

Flip it over once attached, and your top becomes your base.



Step 5

(Optional) Place your lid on top and drill 2 pilot holes through the lid and into the box on each end (to make sure the box will nail together easily at the ceremony).

Step 6

(Optional) Add trim or details to your box.



Step 7

(Optional) Spray paint your box.



Step 8

Decorate the lid, add names and numbers for the wedding date, etc.



Step 9

Fill the box with filler (optional) and add your wine.
