Assembly Instructions

Step 1

Using a tape measure, measure and mark with a pencil on the wood where to cut. Then, trace with a speed square.

Step 2

Using HART circular saw, cut the pine boards to the dimensions (as seen above) in the lumber cut list.

Step 3

When assembling the box, the side boards sit on top of the bottom board, and the top board of the bedside table goes on top of the side boards.

Step 4

Use liquid nails adhesive to glue the boards together. Then, hammer in the finish nails to build the boxes for the nightstands.

Step 5

Use wood clamps to secure while the liquid nails adhesive dries.

Step 6

Paint or stain the wood box part of the bedside tables.



Step 7

Position and hold the hairpin legs on the bottom of the bedside table wood boxes to mark for pilot holes with a pencil.

Step 8

Using a HART drill, predrill for screws using a 1/16" drill bit.

Step 9

Using a HART impact driver, fasten the hairpin legs to the bottom of the bedside table wood boxes (4 legs per nightstand) using the screws provided with the legs to complete the project!
