# Materials

Item	Qty
5' dowel rod	2
3' dowel rod	2
Wood glue	1
Brad nails	6
Wood stain	
Spray paint	

# Tools Used



Miter Saw



Brushless Drill



Orbital Sander

**ALSO NEEDED:** brad nailer

Battery Tip: A 4.0 Ah battery is recommended to be paired with high amp draw tools for maximum efficiency.

# Lumber Cut List

Board*	Description	Cut to	Qty
3ft Dowels	Ladder Rungs	18"	4

# Assembly Instructions

---

## Step 1

Sand the dowel rods. If you are painting for “color blocking,” tape off the end of each ladder side and paint.



---

## Step 2

Stain all of the dowel rods.



---

## Step 3

Cut the smaller dowels (3 ft) to 16" .



---

## Step 4

Attach the appropriate drill bit size to the Brushless Drill, and drill a hole at the desired spacing opposite of each other on the two (5') dowels. (I did every 12")



---

## Step 5

Apply wood glue to each of the holes and insert the cut 16" rung dowels.



---

## Step 6

To make it more secure, use a brad nailer to put one nail in each of the rungs on both sides.

---

## Step 7

Hang your blankets and enjoy!
