PROJECT PLAN

Finished Dimensions: Varies based on Desired Size 6' Long x 20" Wide

Skill Level: Intermediate

Materials

Item	Qty
1 in. x 2 in. x 8 ft. Walnut S4S Board	5 packs (or 1 solid Board)
Wood Oil	1 Bottle
Rag	2
Sand paper 180g,220g, 320g	1 pack

Note: This much walnut runs about \$250 for the size I created. This project can be done with any wood. You can also stain to desired look. The stain must be food grade and safe for food handling. Options above can be changed to meet your budget needs.

Tools Used



Power Drill



Jig Saw



Orbital Sander



Rotary Tool



5-Piece Assorted Hole Saw Set with Tapered Brad Point Tip Arbor



Battery Tip: A 4.0 Ah battery is recommended to be paired with high amp draw tools for maximum efficiency.

Assembly Instructions

Step 1

I bought a whole board that was 6' x 20" wide. If you are not able to find a piece that size you will need to glue and clamp wood pieces together to create desired width.



Step 2

Now that you have that glued together Or your like me and have the piece ready. Now it is time to create the shape! Using a pencil we are going to create a handle.



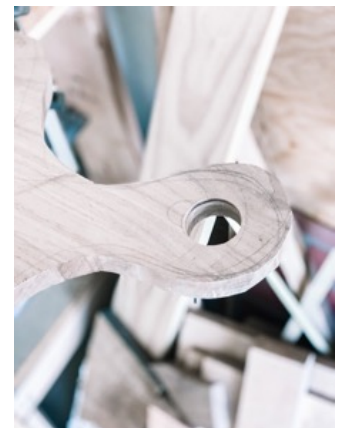
Step 3

Once you have the handle shape you like. We are now going to used the Jigsaw. Following our line creating the handle. I also took the jigsaw and cut rounded edges on the other end.



Step 4

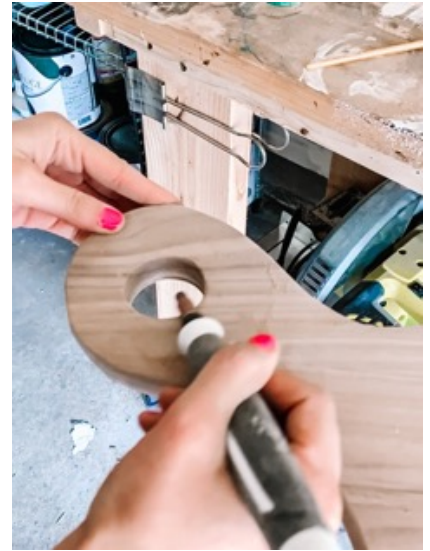
Once you have the handle cut out. Now new need to create the hole using the Hole saw attachments.



Step 5

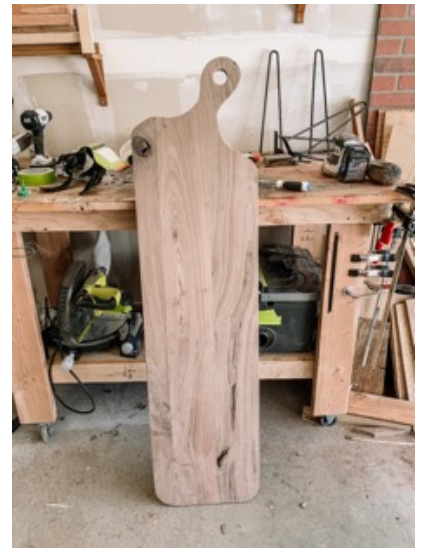
Now that we have all of the piece cut to our desired look. We are now trying to achieve prefect smoothness. Using the orbital sander we sand from 180g all the way to 320g giving it an extremely smooth finish. To sand the inside of the handles hole, I used the Rotary Tool to give it a clean edge.

Pro Tip: While sanding takes a while doing all of the grits will ensure the best finish. As well as making the board look really professional!



Step 6

With a damp cloth or Tack cloth remove all sanding dust.



Step 7

Using a new and dry cloth add finishing oil all over board.



Step 8

Once you have added the oil you are all done! Now your ready to celebrate your loved one!
