# Lumber Cut List

Description	Board*	Cut to	Qty
Table backer	Plywood	33" x 6'	1
Table runners	2x6s	61"	6
Tabletop caps	2x6s	33"	2

# Assembly Instructions

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## Step 1

Cut all material to sizes mentioned above.

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## Step 2

Pocket hole the 2x4 on the top side and also on the sides for the legs to attach to.

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## Step 3

The legs will be pocketed holed to the 2x4s on all 4 sides.

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## Step 4

Pour glue on the ½ sheet of plywood and use a nail gun to attach the 2x6 to the plywood.

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## Step 5

Sand the top and sides of table.

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## Step 6

Apply desired color stain finish, let dry and then apply 2 coats of clear coat.

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## Step 7

Once dry, attach the tabletop to the table frame using the screw going up threw the pocket holes.

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## Step 8

Enjoy your new kitchen table!
