# Materials

3 gallon paint stir sticks	3 packs
Small paint stir sticks	3
Metal bucket	1
Wood glue	
1"small screws	3
Pencil	
Paint & Paintbrush	
Flowers	

\* Starting grit will depend on board surface condition, a rough surface will require starting with a coarse grit first.

Grit is measured in the coarseness of the particles on the sandpaper. The lower the grit number, the coarser the paper. Heavy sanding would require 60 to 80 grit, medium sanding would require 120 to 220 grit, and finish sanding would require 320 to 400 grit. Super fine sanding would be 600 grit and higher.

# Assembly Instructions

# Step 1

Lay all the large paint sticks ruler-side down with little space between each stick.

# Step 2

Using wood glue, attach small stir sticks across large sticks to keep them in place.

#### Step 3

After the wood glue completely dries, pencil a curved pumpkin shape with the stem on top.

#### Step 4

Cut it out with the jigsaw.

#### Step 5

Sand the edges.

#### Step 6

Paint or stain with the color of your choice.

## Step 7

Pre-drill the holes for the bucket.

#### Step 8

Using small screws, drive the screws through the bucket into the wood.

### Step 9

Decorate as you like and enjoy!
