



Pallet Pumpkins

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<u>PROJECT PLAN</u>



Materials

Item	Qty
Pallet	1
Paint (white and green)	2
Stain	1
Coat Hanger	1
Foam Paint Brushes	3
Black Marker	1

^{*} Board Dimensions are "nominal". Actual dimensions are smaller due to lumber industry standards. Cuts are actual length.

Tools Used



Battery Tip: A 4.0 Ah battery is recommended to be paired with high amp draw tools for maximum efficiency.

Assembly Instructions

Step 1

Using a black marker, sketch out two pumpkins and two leaves on pallet. Use the bottom of the pallet for the bottom of the pumpkins so they will stand by themselves.

Step 2

Using your jigsaw, cut along the black line for both pumpkins and leaves. Cut through any of the back of the pallet to separate your pumpkins and leaves.

Step 3

Paint the pumpkins and leaves the desired colors.



Step 4

Using your angle grinder, distress and add detail to your pumpkins.



Step 5

Dry brush stain on pumpkins to accent the distressing.



Step 6

Use your pliers to bend and twist your coat hanger into spirals, and place around pumpkin stem holding the leaf.

Step 7

Display your finished pumpkins!

TIP: To keep the wind from blowing your pumpkins over, place a brick behind each pumpkin resting on the pallet edge.
