

# Materials

Wood Log	1	
3/4" Copper Couplings - Purchased from Walmart	4	
Taper Candles - Purchased from Walmart	4	

# Tools Used



Battery Tip: A 4.0 Ah battery is recommended to be paired with high amp draw tools for maximum efficiency.



### Lumber Cut List

Board*	Description	Cut to	<b>Qty</b>	
Wood Log	Candle Base #1	1"	1	
Wood Log	Candle Base #2	3"	1	
Wood Log	Candle Base #3	5"	1	
Wood Log	Candle Base #4	7"	1	

<sup>\*</sup> Board dimensions are "nominal." Actual dimensions are smaller due to lumber industry standards. Cuts are actual length.

## Assembly Instructions

#### Step 1

Clamp your branch in place on your work surface.

#### Step 2

After applying your safety glasses and gloves, use your chainsaw or reciprocating saw to cut your branch into your desired candle holder length.

#### Step 3

Clamp your cut pieces in place and use your spade bit to drill holes in the center of each piece.

Only drill about half an inch into each wood piece so the top of the 3/4" copper couplings will be exposed. The deeper you drill into the wood slice, the less copper coupling you will see.

### Step 4

After clearing the sawdust, insert copper couplings into each of the holes you just drilled. Place a tapered candle into each coupling.

### Step 5

Project complete! Place your candle holders anywhere you'd like (we think they look great as a centerpiece on a dining room table) and enjoy.
