Also Needed: Brad Nailer, 12" Square, Clamps



Battery Tip: A 4.0 Ah battery is recommended to be paired with high amp draw tools for maximum efficiency.

Lumber Cut List

Description	Board*	Cut to	Qty
Table Top	2x6	24"x6"	2
Table Legs	2x8	22"x8"	2
Shelf	1x6	18"x6"	1
Angle braces	2x6	6"	2

* Board dimensions are "nominal." Actual dimensions are smaller due to lumber industry standards. Cuts are actual length.

Assembly Instructions

Step 1

Cut boards to length.

Step 2

Glue and clamp table top.

Step 3

Cut desired shape at bottom of legs.

Step 4

Attach legs to top with 45 degree braces.

Step 5

Level and attach shelf at desired height.

Step 6

Sand all surfaces, then stain with desired color.

Step 7

Seal with polyurethane.
