# PROJECT PLAN

Skill Level: Beginner



# Materials

Item	Qty	
1x4x8 board*	1	
1.5" screws		
Small campfire canisters	3	
Wood glue		
Wood filler		

\* Board Dimensions are "nominal". Actual dimensions are smaller due to lumber industry standards. Cuts are actual length.

A select/premium board or plywood comes with a smoother surface finish. It is clear or has very few tight knots, and it will have straight and sharp edges. This grade of wood pairs well with other boards or panels better and requires less time to sand and finish.

Battery Tip: A 4.0 Ah battery is recommended to be paired with high amp draw tools for maximum efficiency.



# Assembly Instructions

#### Step 1

Cut 1x4x8 board into three 12" pieces and two 3.5" pieces.

### Step 2

Miter two 12" pieces and two 3.5" at 45° so their sides are no longer parallel.

#### Step 3

Align to form a box with the non-mitered 12" piece on bottom. Secure with wood glue & clamps.

### Step 4

After glue has dried, pre-drill 4 holes in each side and on bottom where pieces touch.

### Step 5

Using the drill/driver, screw pieces together to further reinforce the box.

#### Step 6

Fill screw holes with wood filler, sand with orbital sander, then paint as desired.

## Step 7

Add cannisters and pebbles after drying, then enjoy!
