Long door handles	3
Door knobs	4
Wood glue	
Rope or wire

Also Needed: Clamps



Battery Tip: A 4.0 Ah battery is recommended to be paired with high amp draw tools for maximum efficiency.



#### Lumber Cut List

Description	Board	Cut to*	Qty
Pine board	1 x 8	18"	1
Pine board	1 x 2	18"	1

<sup>\*</sup>Depending on the size of your project, your cuts might be bigger or smaller.

# Assembly Instructions

#### Step 1

First, cut both your 1 x 8 and 1 x 2 to 18" each using the miter saw.

## Step 2

Adhere the  $1 \times 2$  to the top of your  $1 \times 8$  with wood glue using clamps to hold in place.

#### Step 3

Mark where you want your tie hangers (the long door handles), making sure they are at least 1/2" from the edge.

## Step 4

Using the impact drill, drill your holes for each handle.

#### Step 5

Repeat these steps for your belt hangers (the door knobs).

#### Step 6

Sand the entire piece using the orbital sander.



# Step 7

Stain the entire piece prior to adhering the handles and knobs.

## Step 8

Using the impact driver, secure each handle and knob.

## Step 9

Drill holes to the top of the  $1 \times 8$  (at least 1/2" from the edges) to secure a rope or wire for hanging.

## Step 10

You're finished!
