

## Materials

26" x 43" faux shiplap panel		
1" thick 4" x 48" wood	2	
1 ¾" wood screws	6	
½" wood screws	8	
Sawtooth hangers	2	
Push pin hangers (Hillman antique brass 122212)	6	
<sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " pine (8ft)		
Gorilla wood glue		
Wood filler		
Rustoleum linen chalk paint		
Waverly chalk paint Steel		

## Tools Used



#### **Also Needed: Clamps**



Battery Tip: A 4.0 Ah battery is recommended to be paired with high amp draw tools for maximum efficiency.



## Assembly Instructions

#### Step 1

Cut shelves 21.5" long.

#### Step 2

Pre-drill 3 holes 17" up on left side panel.

#### Step 3

Using 1 3/4" screws, screw shelf piece to panel. Repeat going 4" up on the right panel.

#### Step 4

Adhere top decorative piece to panel using wood glue. Then screw  $\frac{1}{4}$ " pine pieces to top decorative piece and main panel using  $\frac{1}{2}$ " screws.

#### Step 5

Fill any gaps with wood filler, and sand any rough areas.

#### Step 6

Paint entire piece with white chalk paint, then dry brush gray chalk paint over top.

### Step 7

Add sawtooth hangers to back, and attach push pin hangers to the front. Enjoy your new shelves!
