# Materials

Item	Qty
3/4 Inch Plywood 4x8	1
Black Paint	1 Quart
Ez Tracer Projector *optional	1
Printed picture of a witch	1
Black Marker	1
Garden stakes	2

\* Board Dimensions are "nominal". Actual dimensions are smaller due to lumber industry standards. Cuts are actual length.

# Tools Used



Jigsaw



Drill



Sander

Also Needed: Brad Nailer



Battery Tip: A 4.0 Ah battery is recommended to be paired with high amp draw tools for maximum efficiency.

# Assembly Instructions

## Step 1

Find a witch silhouette (I just searched the internet) and print it out.

## Step 2

Using the Ez Tracer Projector, I traced the picture with a sharpie on to the plywood.

## Step 3

You can choose the size you would like it to be (I wanted mine to be life-sized). You can always try and free hand the drawing instead of tracing.

## Step 4

Once the drawing is traced, using a drill, drill a hole to close to one of the lines of the drawing outline.

## Step 5

Then using the jigsaw start where the drilled hole is. Once I was done cutting out the witch shape with the jigsaw, I added two coats of black paint.



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## Step 6

If there is a corner or an area that needs to have a better shape, the palm sander will help.

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## Step 7

Once the witch was dry, I turned it over, and using a brad nailer I added garden stakes into the back.

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## Step 8

After that, I put the witch out in my front yard.
